**ORDER GRANTING SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER'S APPLICATION TO REQUIRE
ELECTRONIC SERVICE OF PLEADINGS AND NOTICES**

On this date, the Court heard the *Application to Require Electronic Service of Pleadings and Notices* (the "Application") filed by CANTILO & BENNETT, L.L.P., Special Deputy Receiver of Capson Physicians Insurance Company (the "Special Deputy Receiver").

In accordance with the *Order of Reference to Master* entered February 21, 2019 ("Order of Reference"), the Application was referred to the Master appointed in this proceeding ("Special Master"). The Special Master issued a recommendation pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, finding that:

1. The *Order of Reference* entered by this Court provides that applications filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 443.008 are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;
2. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE § 443.007(d) and the Order of Reference;
3. No objections to the Application were filed;
4. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties affected hereunder; and,
5. The Application should be GRANTED in all respects.

Having considered the Application, the evidence submitted, and the Special Master's recommendation, the Court accepts the recommendation and grants the Application.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Application to Require Electronic Service of Pleadings and Notices is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Special Deputy Receiver and all other parties at interest, parties requesting notice and all other individuals and entities shall file any pleading, plea, motion, applications, notices and all other matters requiring service in this proceeding by e-mail;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Special Deputy Receiver shall, by its counsel, Gregory Pierce, whose email address is *gpierce@gpiercelaw.com*, create and maintain a current list of e-mail addresses of all parties and provide the list and a copy of this Order to all parties in interest and parties requesting notice;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all parties at interest and parties requesting notice shall provide to the Special Deputy Receiver's counsel an e-mail address;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Special Deputy Receiver may, at its discretion, serve any pleading or notice by any other means authorized by TEX. INS. CODE § 443.007, the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, or other order of this Court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Order constitutes a final order fully resolving all issues relating to the Application, provided that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to issue further orders pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE Chapter 443.
