**ORDER GRANTING SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER’S AMENDED APPLICATION
FOR APPROVAL OF FIRST REPORT OF CLAIMS**

On this date, the Court heard the Amended Application for Approval of the SDR’s First Report of Claims (the “Application”) filed by CANTILO & BENNETT, L.L.P., solely in its capacity as Special Deputy Receiver of Capson Physicians Insurance Company (the “SDR” and “CPIC,” respectively). The SDR appeared by and through its counsel.

Having considered the Application, the Court finds as follows:

1. The *Supplemental Order of Reference to Master* provide that motions filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 443.007 and § 443.258 are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;
 2. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE §443.007 and the *Supplemental Order of Reference to Master*;
 3. The Texas Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association filed its acknowledgement and waiver;
 4. No objections to the Application were filed;
 5. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties affected hereunder;
- and
6. The SDR’s Application should be granted in all respects.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:
